1. BECOME <u>AWARE</u> OF MY THIRST.

"Anyone who is thirsty may come to me!" (John 7:37, NLT)

2. SHIFT MY THIRST TO JESUS.

"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied." (Matthew 5:6, NASB)

"As a deer longs for a stream of cool water, so I long for you, O God. I thirst for you, the living God; when can I go and worship in your presence?" (Psalm 42:1–2, GN)

a. Righteousness is a right relationship with God.

"This Good News tells us how God makes us right in his sight. This is accomplished from start to finish by faith. As the Scriptures say, "It is through faith that a righteous person has life." (Romans 1:17, NLT)

b. Righteousness a flourishing life.

"In the way of righteousness is life, And in its pathway there is no death." (Proverbs 12:28, NASB)

"Once you're convinced that he is right and righteous, you'll recognize that all who practice righteousness are God's true children." (1 John 2:29, Message)

c. Righteousness is the gift of God through Christ.

"For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. Yet God, in his grace, freely makes us right in his sight. He did this through Christ Jesus when he freed us from the penalty for our sins. For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin. People are made right with God when they believe that Jesus sacrificed his life, shedding his blood. This sacrifice shows that God was being fair when he held back and did not punish those who sinned in times past," (Romans 3:23–25, NLT)
